WHAT DOES LEVEL 7 MEAN?

The National Qualifications Framework (NFQ) is a framework through which all learning achievements may be measured and related to each other in a coherent way. The many different types and sizes of qualifications are organised based on their level of knowledge, skill and competence.

The Certificate of Credit Union Compliance and Risk sits at Level 7 on the NFQ in the Republic of Ireland which is equivalent to Level 5 on the NQF in Northern Ireland.

A Level 7 award demonstrates that what learners should know, understand and be able to do is at the same level as an Ordinary Bachelor Degree and this is an indicator of the challenge level involved in completing this programme. The certificate status of the programme is based on the duration, i.e. one academic year (whereas a degree requires 3/4 years).
